Sportsmanship

All students are strongly urged to participate in, or attend, school sports activities. Good sportsmanship dictates that visiting teams be treated as guests and applauded upon making a good play. **It is not whether we win or lose that counts, but how we play the game.**

Scholastic Standing:

You will need to pass three (3) units of work in the previous quarter in order to compete. You cannot regain your athletic eligibility by making up academic deficiencies or failures of the regular school year during the summer months. Halfway through each grading quarter, a progress report will be filled out and mailed home. Students in academic difficulty should arrange for tutoring by students through the N.H.S. tutoring service, private tutors, or seek extra help from their teachers after school.

Athletic Fees:

The Pelham School Board approved the following fee schedule for student athletes:

1. Fee per sport 50.00
2. A maximum per individual cost annually 125.00
3. A maximum per family cost annually 250.00
4. A full refund for athletes who are cut from a team prior to the first game. A pro-rated refund for athletes who fail to complete the season because of illness, injury, or ineligibility.
5. Full or partial waivers granted by the principal for students who qualify for

free/reduced lunch or can demonstrate hardship and need.

*Additional fees may be charged for the football program.

Financial Remuneration:

If you, at any time, receive any type of financial remuneration for participating in sports that are organized by the NHIAA, your athletic eligibility will be terminated from all high school sports from the date of the infraction. Accepting a nominal fee for instructing, supervising, or officiating in an organized youth sports program or recreation, playground, or camp activities shall not jeopardize your amateur status. If you sign a professional playing contract, you will lose your amateur status in whatever the sport involved.

Semesters:

You are eligible for interscholastic competition for no more than eight (8) consecutive semesters once you enter grade nine (9). Participation in grades seven (7) and eight (8) does not count towards the eight (8) allowable semesters. If you attend a high school in a foreign country, the eight (8) semester rule is still in effect.
